#### PREPARING YOUR HOME FOR WINTER

Today we broke out our scarves, gloves, and hats and put them in a basket by the front door. I've started a list that I want to share that can help you prepare your home for winter.

#### Tips to ensure your home is safe & secure upon your return:

- Disconnect your water hose, and insulate exterior pipes and faucets.
- Blow out your sprinkler system if needed.
- Check the weather stripping on your doors. Hold an incense or candle nearby to locate air leaks.
- Make sure to latch your windows shut to keep more heat in. Using window insulation kits with shrink wrap will block drafts while allowing light in.
- Clean out your gutters. Debris in gutters can block and collect water that can then freeze and damage the gutter.
- Seal cracks in your concrete driveway. Water can find its way into the cracks and then make them larger over time.
- Check and replace your AC/furnace filters. This should be done every 30-90 days.
- Feed your lawn a late fall winterizer, and replace the mulch around landscaping.
- Drain the gas out of your lawnmower before storing it for the season.

#### **DIY HOUSEHOLD TIPS**

As winter is now upon us a good tip to help prevent costly repairs is to disconnect your outside water hoses from the faucet. It is best to store your water hoses in the garage or a storage shed to protect them from freezing and

breaking. Once the hose is removed a faucet cover should be installed to prevent your outside faucet from freezing your homes internal water lines that could rupture causing very expensive repairs and damage to your home. A faucet cover is very inexpensive (\$1.99 at Home Depot) and very easy to install. Place the elastic loop inside the faucet cover around the outside faucet. Then simply pull the elastic cord so that the cover is snug



against your house. Your outside faucets are now protected from freezing. On my home, I take this one step further and wrap my outside faucet in a towel that will fit inside the faucet cover for added protection.
