#### **The Top 3 Neighborhood Violations & How to avoid them:**

- Yard maintenance: It's hard with a busy schedule and unplanned rain to get out and mow, edge, and trim our yards but curb appeal is important and keeps our neighborhood looking nice. Thankfully, there are several local companies that are reasonably priced that can assist on short notice. Ideally, yards should be maintained every week to week and a half to help cut down on the reminders.
- Vehicles & Trailers: Please be mindful of your neighbor's driveways and mailboxes when
  parking on the street or having company over. Trailers, RVs, campers, boats, and other such
  vehicles are encouraged to be moved within 72hrs of one's front yard. They can, however, be
  stored in a garage or backyard as long as they are not visible from the street.
- <u>Miscellaneous items located in front yards</u>: Keep in mind, old furniture, fence pickets, concrete blocks, etc. are only to be put out front on trash days or bulk pick up. #### Citrus Cinnamon Chicken in the Slow Cooker

### Ingredients

1 cup ketchup

1/4 cup instant tapioca

1 cup orange juice

1 stick cinnamon

6 pounds chicken thighs, bone-in, skin removed

#### Instructions

- 1. In a bowl, combine the ketchup, tapioca, and orange juice. Put about half in the bottom of your slow cooker. Place the cinnamon stick on top of the sauce.
  - 2. Put a single layer of chicken in the pot, spoon some sauce over each piece. Add another layer of chicken and sauce. Repeat if necessary.
    - 3. Cook on low 6 8 hours, or high 3 4 hours or until chicken is done.
